

Appeals Procedure for Entry to College 2024-25

If your child has been refused a place at the College, you have the right to appeal against that decision.

As an Academy, Appeals are heard by a special Governors panel called an Appeal Panel.

In the event that the College is oversubscribed the Admissions Policy explains how numbers will be allocated according to the Admissions criteria.

If you are informed by the local Authority that the College has not been able to offer a place to your son, it should make clear the reasons for this. You should think carefully about whether or not you wish to appeal against this decision.

You will need to think about:

- the College's policy for admitting pupils
- and specific reasons it has given for not admitting your child.
- your reasons for wanting your child to attend the College and the strength of your case.

Appeals must be made in writing using the Appeals Form and must set out the reasons on which an appeal is made. Once this is received then you will be contacted with an invitation to an Appeals Panel meeting.

The deadline for receiving Appeals is Friday 29th March 2024.
