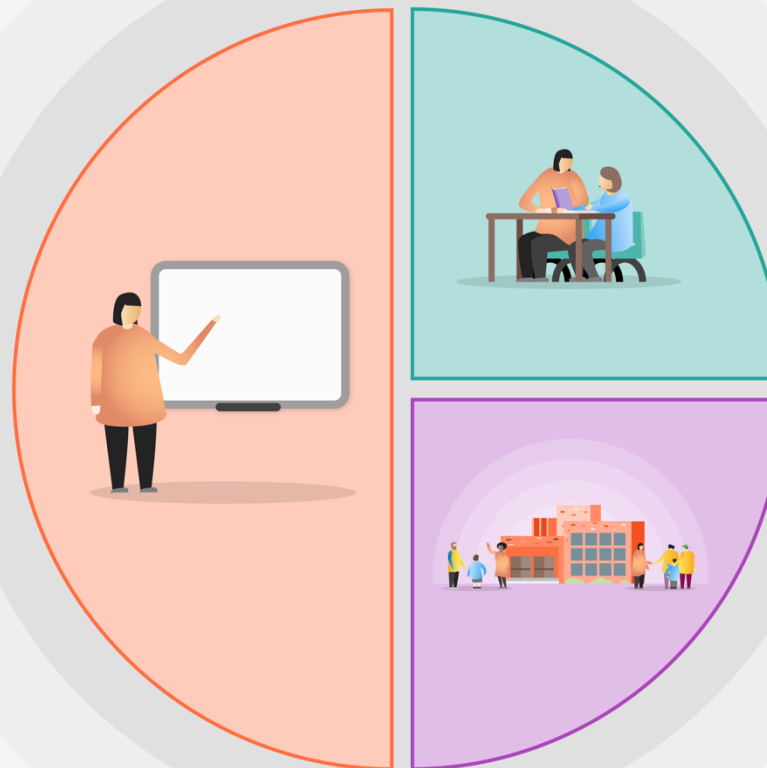




1 Teaching

- Improving online learning facilities for students and rewarding use
- Implementation of Knowledge Organisers
- Improved use of Assessment for Learning (AfL) to identify and plug gaps

- Improving delivery of lessons during periods of teacher isolation
- Purchase of National College subscription
- Reduction of NQT teaching allocations wherever possible to support their professional development
- Purchase of visualisers for all classrooms
- Purchase of mini white boards and pens for all students year 7-13
