## **RE: Collection of GCSE / Level 2 Vocational Examination Results – Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022**

I hope you are keeping well and your son is recovering from the stress and exertion of exams.

The following information is very important as it relates to how your son can collect their results from the College. Students will be able to collect their results from **8:30 – 11:00 am on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022**, from the Sixth Form in main school building:

Students should arrive via the service road entrance and enter via the staircase by the gates. They should proceed up the staircase and into the Sixth Form Centre where they then go into the main Sixth Form area.

Once they have collected their results, students will have access to teaching and careers staff who will be available should students wish to discuss their results and what their options may be. They will also be able to complete their 6<sup>th</sup> Form enrolment. Students will then leave site via the exit in the back of the Sixth Form Centre.

Those who are unable to collect their results in person and need them posted, must provide the reception team or the Exams Officer with a **self-addressed and stamped envelope before results days preferably by 21<sup>st</sup> July 2022.**

Please note that if **anyone** else is collecting results on behalf of a student, the **student** must write a signed letter stating the named person who will collect the results. On the day, that named person must bring a valid photographic ID. We cannot give results to anyone without the candidate's permission.

If you have any old textbooks or items of uniform, blazers and ties particularly, that is no longer required, please could we encourage students to bring these with them on results day and donate them. We are currently in the process of trying to build a resource library of textbooks for students who may be unable to afford to purchase their own books. Therefore, any donations would be greatly appreciated.
