The rigour of teaching and learning combined with our college respects has created a unique learning environment where pupils flourish both academically and personally.

It has been another set of excellent results at GCSE for the school, with 77% of students achieving a grade 4 or higher in English and 70% a grade 4 or higher in Maths. 45% of pupils achieved a grade 5 or higher in English and Maths, and we are very proud of those Pupils achieving 9s across the majority of their subjects.

Congratulations to Ashwini Nir and Gibril Barry who both achieved nine grade 9s and one grade 8, outstanding achievements. Muhammad Sadiq also did really well in achieving seven grade 9s and two grade 7s.

St Joseph's College currently has an Attainment 8 score of 45.5.

10% more pupils undertake the English Baccalaureate against the national average of 35%.
