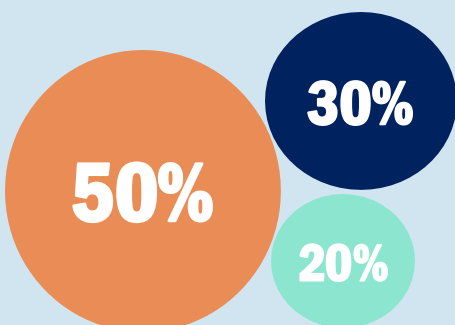


## SUBJECT OVERVIEW

Building on knowledge, understanding and skills gained at GCSE, A-level students will study Spanish-speaking society and how it has been shaped socially and culturally and how it continues to change. You will also study the grammatical system and structure of the language. In addition to developing advanced Spanish language skills, the course also helps students develop a range of transferable skills including communication, critical thinking, research skills and creativity. Assessment A-Levels will be linear; students will sit all exams at the end of the two-year course.
