Year 11 Easter Revision Support Sessions

At St Joseph's College we are committed to ensuring that all students achieve their potential in their imminent GCSE examinations. Following the Easter holidays there are just 14 school days before the examinations start. Next term will be a significant and demanding month for all Year 11 students as the final drive on revision concludes and they start to complete their GCSE examinations. These exams are students' opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and be rewarded for all their hard work, commitment and dedication to their studies over the past three years and ultimately 10 years in education.

We are extremely pleased to be able to offer students Easter Support Sessions. The sessions are designed to aid students in structuring their revision over the school break and to support students in achieving the highest possible grades they can. We strongly urge students to attend the sessions offered and need and value your support in encouraging this.

Below are the details of the support sessions on offer to Year 11 learners. Students are advised to speak to their teachers regarding the sessions they should attend. Sessions are charged at £1.50 a session (to cover the reprographic costs of the session) and places therefore need to be secured on Parent Pay. All available sessions will be available to book on Parent Pay from Thursday 28 March until Wednesday 3 April. Securing a place on Parent Pay will act as the form of parental consent for your son to attend. Please note, it is important your son arrives at the start time indicated below. This is to avoid any disruption to the learning and progress of students during the session. Students that arrive late may not be permitted to take part in the support session.

Students do not need to wear school uniform and will be permitted to go off site during times they are not in a support session and during breaks. Breaks will be provided to the students during support sessions exceeding two hours. Throughout the sessions and whilst on school premises, it is important students conduct themselves in a diligent and respectful manner.

In addition to the support sessions, we are opening our 6th Form Area as a Private Study Area from 09.00-14.00 on the dates below. This will provide students with a focused, quiet space of study. Students are expected to bring revision material to this Study Area and to study quietly. Students can attend any day listed below and will need to sign in and out upon arrival and exit.
