The Year 11 Parents Academic Review Evening is an opportunity for you to meet your son's subject teachers to discuss their progress for a key year in their academic lives. We are holding this event in person, **NOT** virtually, and it will be based in our Main Hall, on **Tuesday 6**th **February 2024 - 3.30 pm to 6.00 pm**. We will be using our online forum, SchoolCloud to book appointments to see teachers.

Booking appointments will go 'live' from **6 pm on Thursday 18th January 2024.** Please book early as teachers only have limited appointment slots available.

The procedures for the virtual event are as follows:

- Appointments are strictly 5 minutes long.
- The link for the system is repeated here: https://SJCdelasalle.schoolcloud.co.uk/
- Access is via the service road and limited parking is available on the playground.

When you are ready to book, please click on the link and enter the date of birth for your son. There will be no bookings available until it goes live. The booking system is very intuitive the information you enter MUST be the same as we have on our database for your son, but there is a PDF guide attached that will guide you through the process.

On the day please try to be on time for your appointments as it may not be possible to reschedule or fit you in if you miss your appointment.

An Options Presentation will be given in room H22 which is above the Main Hall, this will explain the process for choosing Options, a copy of the Options Book and information on key dates for submitting your son's option choices. The presentations are at **3.30 pm, 4.30 pm amd 5.30 pm and will be about 30 minutes**. Please allow time when booking your appointment times to attend one of the presentations.

This is a very important and exciting time in your son's education at St Joseph's College. Until now, students have had very little choice about which subjects they study as they have had to follow the National Curriculum. As they move into Key Stage 4 (KS4), students now have some choices about subjects they would like to study.
